	23	of California, and without admitting or denying such activities, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED		
	24	AND AGREED between SoccerTots, Inc. and Edward Kent Gold (hereafter collectively		
	25	"Respondents") and the California Corporations Commissioner ("Commissioner"), as follows:		
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- 1. Respondents stipulate to the issuance of the Desist and Refrain Order, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, directing Respondents to desist and refrain from the further offer and sale of unregistered franchises in violation of the Franchise Investment Law.
- 2. Respondents hereby waive all rights to any hearing or appeal of the Desist and Refrain Order.
- 3. Respondents stipulate that the delivery by certified mail of the executed Desist and Refrain Order issued by the Commissioner to their counsel, Edward R. Culhane, Esq., shall constitute valid service of the Order.
- 4. Respondents and the Commissioner agree that this Stipulation and the accompanying Desist and Refrain Order are a full and final resolution of the investigation of unregistered franchised sold and operated by Respondents to date. Subject to these Stipulations, no fines or penalties will be imposed for the sale or operation of unregistered franchises to date.
- 5. Respondents and the Commissioner agree that nothing in the Stipulations or the accompanying Desist and Refrain Order is to be interpreted as interfering with the existing business relationships with the existing four "licensees" in the State of California. However, Respondents may not extend the terms of the existing "licenses" without either registering it as a franchise or relying upon and complying with the terms of any applicable exemption or exception pursuant to the Franchise Investment Law.
- Respondents are aware that the Department of Corporations has not reviewed any
  new or revised licensing agreements for the purpose of determining whether such agreement is in
  compliance with the Franchise Investment Law.
- 7. Respondents acknowledge that remedies for violations of the Franchise Investment Law are not exclusive and may be sought and employed in any combination to enforce the purpose and provisions of this law.
- 7. Respondents agree that nothing in this Stipulation shall preclude the Commissioner, or his agents or employees, to the extent authorized by law, from assisting or cooperating in any investigation and/or action brought by any other federal, state or county agency. Respondents
