

## NOTICE OF SECOND MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEBT COLLECTION LICENSING ACT

### PRO 01/23 Defining "Net Proceeds Generated by California Debtor Accounts" and Specifying Information Required in Annual Report

To Interested Persons:

On February 9, 2024, the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation published a Notice of Rulemaking Action to define the term "net proceeds generated by California debtor accounts" and to specify the information required to be included in the annual report under the Debt Collection Licensing Act. On June 17, 2024, the Commissioner proposed modifications to the proposed regulations.

After consideration of public comments to the modified text, the Commissioner is again proposing modifying the originally proposed text. The Commissioner is hereby providing notice of second modifications in accordance with subdivision (c) of Government Code section 11346.8 and section 44 of title 1 of the California Code of Regulations.

In the text of the proposed regulations showing the second modifications, additions are shown in italics and deletions are shown in italics with a strikethrough. These changes are not yet effective and will not be effective until approved by the Office of Administrative Law and filed with the Secretary of State in accordance with Government Code section 11349.3.
