WHEREAS, Respondent failed to comply with the Rescission and Refund, Notice to Consent Order and Remedial Education requirements in the Order because Respondent asserts that it is insolvent.

WHEREAS, Respondent wishes to resolve all matters, pending or that relate to matters previously filed with the Commissioner by Respondent, including the unfulfilled portions of the Order (Rescission and Refund, Notice to Consent Order and Remedial Education), with the Commissioner.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the terms and conditions set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Respondent waives all rights to any hearing of the Stipulation to Consent Order (Stipulation) and waive any review by a court of law of the Stipulation.
- Respondent acknowledges and agrees that it violated Corporations Code sections
 31123 and 31203 of the FIL set forth in the Stipulation.
- 3. Respondent agrees to comply with the Desist and Refrain Order set forth in the Order as follows: Pursuant to Corporations Code section 31406, Skill Samurai, Inc. is hereby ordered to desist and refrain from the violations of Corporations Code sections 31123 and 31203.
- 4. Respondent agrees to not offer or sell franchises, or assist in the offer or sell of franchises, in the state of California until December 31, 2029.
- 5. Respondent agrees that, if Respondent becomes solvent, Respondent shall refund all monies to Skill Samauri Inc. franchisees as set forth in the Order.
- 6. Respondent agrees that nothing in this Stipulation shall preclude the Commissioner, or her agents or employees, to the extent authorized by law, from assisting in any investigation and/or action brought by any other federal, state, or local agency, or from referring the matter to any of those agencies; and Respondent further agrees that this Stipulation shall not bind or otherwise prevent any of those agencies from performing their duties.
- 7. Respondent enters into this Stipulation voluntarily and without coercion and acknowledges that no promises, threats, or assurances have been made by the Commissioner or her agents or employees about this Stipulation.

8. Respondent agrees that this Stipulation may be executed in one or more separate		
counterparts, each of which when so executed, shall be deemed an original, and these counterparts		
shall together constitute and be one and the same instrument.		
9. Respondent hereby acknowledges that the Stipulation are and will be a matter of		
public record.
