RE: Grow Escrow, Inc.

Dear Sir/Madam:

Effective October 2, 2024, I was appointed as Conservator to process the distribution of trust funds of Grow Escrow, Inc. (GE), pursuant to Section 17630 of the California Financial Code.

The Department of Financial Protection and Innovation's (DFPI) records indicate that you have, or at one time had, an escrow account at GE. Accordingly, a claim form is enclosed for you to complete and file with the Conservator, if necessary. Please note that you only need to complete and file the claim form if you believe that (1) you deposited funds with GE that were not properly disbursed or (2) GE is still holding funds that belong to you. For example, if funds you deposited with GE were not disbursed in accordance with the escrow instructions, or if escrow trust funds were disbursed by GE to you via check and you were unable to cash the check, you must file a claim as set forth, below.

You must complete the enclosed claim form, specifying the amount of your claim and the exact name of the person(s) or firm to whom payment is requested to be made. The name(s) must correspond to those originally given to GE and included in the escrow instructions and other documents. The names may not be changed. Your completed claim form will be compared with the information contained in GE's records.

Please complete and return the enclosed claim form to the Blake Alsbrook (Conservator for Grow Escrow, Inc.), Ervin Cohen & Jessup, LLP, 9401 Wilshire Boulevard, 12th Floor, Beverly Hills, CA 90212 on or before December 10, 2024. A prompt response from the majority of claimants by this date will better enable the Conservator to more quickly make distributions.

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ALL CLAIM FORMS MUST HAVE COPIES OF ALL PERTINENT DOCUMENTS SUPPORTING THE CLAIM ATTACHED.
