22	1. On November 20, 2024, the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation	
23	(Commissioner) issued an Accusation and the Commissioner's Notice of Intention to Issue an Orde	
24	Revoking the escrow agent's license (Notice of Intention) of APN Escrow Services, Inc.	
25	(Respondent).	
26	2. On December 12, 2024, the Respondent was served with the Accusation, Notice of	
27	Intention, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, and Government Code sections 11507.5,	

11507.6, and 11507.7 (collectively, Revocation Action).

- 3. The Notice of Intention specifically informed the Respondent that unless a request for a hearing, as evidenced by the mailing or delivery of the Notice of Defense, was received by the Commissioner within 15 days after the Revocation Action was served, the revocation order may be entered at any time thereafter without a hearing. To date, no request for a hearing has been made by the Respondent.
- 4. The Accusation that was previously served upon Respondent is incorporated by reference and states the reasons for this order.

NOW, GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the escrow agent's license of APN Escrow Services, Inc. be revoked effective this date.

This Order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of consumers, and consistent with the purposes, policies, and provisions of the Escrow Law.
