23 The Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation (Complainant) finds that the
24 annual assessment required by Financial Code section 22107 was due October 31, 2025, that the
25 Complainant duly notified the Respondent to pay the overdue assessment on or about November 14,
26 2025, and that the assessment remains unpaid by the Respondent.

27 THEREFORE, GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, Respondent's California Financing Law
28 License is hereby revoked effective December 31, 2025, pursuant to Financial Code section 22107,
1 unless the annual assessment is received in good funds by the Department of Financial Protection
2 and Innovation Accounting Office located on 651 Bannon Street, Suite 300, Sacramento, CA 95811
3 no later than the close of business on December 30, 2025. On the effective date of this Order, if the
4 annual assessment remains unpaid as of the close of business on December 30, 2025, you are hereby
5 ordered and directed to discontinue the making or brokering of any loan made pursuant to the
6 California Financing Law. (Financial Code section 22000 et seq.) On the effective date of this
7 Order, if the annual assessment remains unpaid as of the close of business on December 30, 2025,
8 you are also hereby ordered and directed to discontinue all activity conducted pursuant to Sections
9 22340 and 22600 of the Financial Code within 60 days of the effective date of this Order.

10 ORDER SUMMARILY REVOKING CALIFORNIA FINANCING LAW LICENSE PURSUANT
11 TO FINANCIAL CODE SECTION 22107

1 This Order is to remain in full force and effect until the further written order of the
2 Complainant.

3 Section 22107(d) of the Financial Code provides as follows:

4 If a licensee fails to pay the assessment on or before the 31st day of October,
5 the commissioner may by order summarily suspend or revoke the certificate
6 issued to the licensee. If, after an order is made, a request for hearing is filed
7 in writing within 30 days, and a hearing is not held within 60 days thereafter,
8 the order is deemed rescinded as of its effective date. During any period when
9 its certificate is revoked or suspended, a finance lender or broker licensee and
10 any mortgage loan originator licensee employed by the finance lender or
11 broker shall not conduct business pursuant to this division except as may be
12 permitted by order of the commissioner. However, the revocation, suspension
13 or surrender of a certificate shall not affect the powers of the commissioner as
14 provided in this division.
