WHEREAS, in October or November of 2025, Private Pacific Money, Inc. (Private Pacific Money) halted its monthly distributions to its investors and suspended all investor withdrawals. In December of 2025, the company appointed a Chief Restructuring Officer.

On March 9, 2026, representatives of Private Pacific Money confirmed that the company experienced a severe liquidity crunch in December, leaving it without sufficient funds to continue investor distributions.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation is engaged in an examination and investigation of Pacific Private Money related to its California Financing Law license.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the intent of the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation to issue an order, three days after service of this notification, suspending the California Financing Law license of Pacific Private Money, Inc., No. 605-4605, for a period of 30 days, pending investigation, pursuant to Financial Code section 22710.

Pursuant to Financial Code section 22716, the order will not impair or affect the obligation of any preexisting lawful contract between Pacific Private Money, Inc. and any borrower.

Unless a request for hearing, as evidenced by the mailing or delivery of such a request, is received prior to the date by which the Commissioner may issue the intended order suspending the license, the Commissioner may enter the order against Respondent at any time thereafter without a hearing.
