25 Pursuant to Government Code section 11522, you are hereby notified that on or about  
26 October 10, 2011, Respondent, Silicon Valley Community Ventures, Inc. now known as Pacific  
27 Community Ventures, Inc. (“Silicon”), filed a Petition for Reinstatement of License or Reduction of  
28 Penalty (“Petition”) with the California Corporations Commissioner (“Commissioner”). A true and  
correct copy of the Petition without exhibits is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.

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The Commissioner, on April 15, 2008 to be effective May 1, 2008, issued an order revoking the California Finance Lender Law license of Silicon for failure to file its 2007 annual report required by Financial Code section 22159(a). A true and correct copy of the revocation order is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 2. At the time of revocation, Silicon was also in violation of Financial Code sections 22108 and 22153 for failing to notify the Commissioner of its change in corporate officers, name, and business location.
