This Court having read and considered the motion, memorandum of points and authorities, complaint, declarations and exhibits, and all other evidence presented, having heard the arguments of counsels and good cause appearing therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: The Court GRANTS a Preliminary Injunction to preserve the status quo. The above-named defendants, and each of them, and their officers, agents, employees, representatives, and all persons acting in concert or participating with them, are restrained and enjoined from engaging in or performing, directly or indirectly, any and all of the acts as set forth in

1 this complaint, including:

2 (1) Violating California Financial Code section 22161 by advertising, printing,
3 displaying, publishing, distributing, or broadcasting, or causing or permitting to be advertised,
4 printed, displayed, published, distributed, or broadcasted in any manner, any statement or
5 representation with regard to the business subject to the provisions of the California Finance Lenders
6 Law (California Financial Code section 22000 et seq.) that is deceptive and/or misleading or that
7 omits information that is necessary to make the statements not false, misleading or deceptive,
8 including but not limited to those statement or representations alleged in the First Cause of Action
9 relating to the marketing of loans to consumers, including the rates, terms, or conditions for making
10 or negotiating loans; and

11 (2) Destroying, mutilating, concealing, altering, transferring or otherwise
12 disposing of, in any manner, any books, records, documents, correspondence, brochures, manuals, or
13 other documents of any kind relating to the brokered loans in the possession, custody or control of
14 any of the defendants until further order of this Court.

15 Defendant A L G Capital, Inc. and all Does, and their officers, directors, successors in
16 interest, controlling persons, agents, employees, attorneys in fact, and all other persons acting in
17 concert or participating with them, are restrained and enjoined from, directly or indirectly, violating
18 California Financial Code section 22338, subdivision (a), by failing to deliver statements to
19 borrowers that includes the information required by California Financial Code section 22338,
20 subsection (a).
