 Order Final; (4) Notice of Defense; and (5) Government Code Sections 11507.5, 11507.6 and 11507
 (documents referenced hereinafter collectively as "Administrative Pleadings").

On March 29, 2006, the Commissioner also issued and then served ALC, by certified mail,
 return receipt requested, with copies of the following: (1) Notice of Intention to Issue Order Levying
 Administrative Penalties Pursuant to Corporations Code Section 25252; (2) Statement in Support of Order
 Levying Administrative Penalties Pursuant to Corporations Code Section 25252; (3) Notice of Defense; and
 (4) Government Code Sections 11507.5, 11507.6, 11507.7 (documents referenced hereinafter collectively as
 "Administrative Penalty Pleadings").

4. In lieu of administrative hearings on the Administrative Pleadings and the Administrative Pleadings, the Commissioner and ALC agree to stipulate to the following:

STIPULATION

A. ALC stipulates to the issuance of an Order Levying Administrative Penalties Pursuant to Corporations Code Section 25252.

B. ALC stipulates to the issuance of an Order to Discontinue Violations Pursuant to Corporations
 Code Section 25249.

C. ALC agrees Austin Lemoine Capital Management and/or Austin Joseph Lemoine agrees to pay
\$2,250 as administrative penalties ordered under California Corporations Code section 25252, no later than
July 3, 2006, otherwise ALC will be deemed by the Commissioner to be in violation of the Order Levying
Administrative Penalties Pursuant to Corporations Code section 25252 and ALC may be subject to further
action provided by law.

F. ALC waives any rights to any hearings or appeals on both the Final Order to Discontinue Violations and the Order Levying Administrative Pleadings Pursuant to Corporations Code Section 25252.

G. ALC acknowledges that pursuant to Corporations Code section 25255, remedies for violations of the Corporate Securities Law and the rules promulgated there under are not exclusive and may be sought and employed in any combination to enforce the purpose and provisions of the law.

H. ALC enters into this Stipulation voluntarily and without coercion and acknowledges that no promises, threats or assurances have been made by the Commissioner or any officer, or agent thereof, about this Stipulation and Agreement.

I. ALC and the Commissioner agree that this Stipulation may be executed in one or more separate counterparts, each of which when so executed, shall be deemed an original. Such counterparts shall together constitute and be one and the same instrument.

J. ALC acknowledges that nothing in this Stipulation shall preclude the Commissioner, or his agents or employees, to the extent authorized by law, from assisting or cooperating in any investigation and/or
