the Annual Report is not filed.¹

Pursuant to Financial Code section 17406, CENTRAL CALIFORNIA ESCROW CO. was required to submit its Annual Report for the fiscal year ended October 31, 2009 to the Commissioner on or before February 16, 2010.

On or about September 22, 2009, Complainant notified CENTRAL CALIFORNIA ESCROW CO. in writing that its Annual Report was due February 16, 2010 for the fiscal year ending October 31, 2009. CENTRAL CALIFORNIA ESCROW CO. failed to file the Annual Report by February 16, 2010.

On or about February 23, 2010, a follow up demand letter was sent to Respondent concerning its failure to file the Annual Report. Respondent was notified in the letter that failure to file to the Annual Report could result in assessment of penalties calculated from the expiration date of the 10-day demand letter, a special examination and/or administrative action. CENTRAL CALIFORNIA ESCROW CO. has yet to file the Annual Report as required by Financial Code section 17406.

Financial Code Section 17408, subdivisions (b) – (e) provides as follows:

- (b) The commissioner may impose, by order, a penalty on any person who fails, within the time specified in any written demand of the commissioner, (1) to make and file with the commissioner any report required by law or requested by the commissioner... The amount of the penalty shall be one hundred dollars (\$100) for each day for the first five days the report or information is overdue and, thereafter, five hundred dollars (\$500) for each day the report or information is overdue.
- (c) If, after an order has been made under subdivision (b), a request for hearing is filed in writing within 30 days of the date of service of the order by the person to whom the order was directed, a hearing shall be held in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, and the commissioner shall have all the powers granted under that chapter.
- (d) If the person fails to file a written request for a hearing within 30 days of the date of service of the order, the order imposing the penalty shall be deemed a final order of the commissioner, and the penalty shall be paid within

¹ Accrued Penalties = \$50.00 per day for the first five (5) days of delinquency (March 6, 2010 - March 11, 2010) then \$250.00 per day for each day of delinquency thereafter.

five business days.

(e) If a hearing is requested, the penalty shall be paid within five business days after the effective date of any decision in the case ordering payment to be paid.
