DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER

(For violations of section 31110 of the Corporations Code)

The California Corporations Commissioner finds that:

1. The Cure Service Group, Inc. is a Washington corporation that was formed on January 2, 2002. Its principal place of business is 106 NW 36th Street, Seattle, Washington 98107. In or around 2002, The Cure Service Group, Inc. began offering franchises for the operation of water damage restoration services, carpet cleaning services, related cleaning services and ancillary products. On March 29, 2004, the company filed an application for franchise registration pursuant to Corporations Code section 31121 for registration to sell franchises under the name 1-800-Water Damage in California.

- 2. The California Department of Corporations issued an Order approving Franchise registration on June 4, 2004. A renewal application was filed on March 27, 2006, with the California Department of Corporations.
- 3. During the period from January 2, 2002, through June 4, 2004, prior to and during the pendency of the application for registration, The Cure Service Group, Inc. sold unregistered franchises under the name of 1-800-Water Damage and Cure Water Damage to California residents in violation of Corporations Code section 31110.
- 4. Rick Stonell aka Rick Stowell was the Chief Executive Officer of The Cure Service Group, Inc. and from the date of incorporation to December 16, 2005, acted as one of its principal officers and directors in fact, exercising management responsibility and control with regard to all facets of its operations, including the franchises offered by the company. In addition, at all times mentioned herein, Rick Stonell aka Rick Stowell was personally involved in the sale of franchises during the time period when The Cure Service Group, Inc. was not registered.
- 5. Lisa Bongi was the Director of Operations for the Cure Water Damage, Inc., from January, 1997 to May, 1998. Lisa Bongi was the President of The Cure Service Group, Inc., from January 2, 2002 to December 16, 2005. As of December 16, 2005, Lisa Bongi is the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Cure Service Group, Inc.
- 6. From June 4, 2004, to the present, The Cure Service Group, Inc., offered franchises to California residents and failed to disclose the sale of five unregistered franchises from 2002 to 2004 in violation of Corporations Code section 31200.
- 7. While offering franchise opportunities from 2002 to the present, The Cure Service Group, Inc., Rick Stonell aka Rick Stowell and Lisa Bongi failed to disclose a 1992 lawsuit filed in Contra Costa County, California for unlawful and unfair business practices that resulted in an adverse judgment and fine on August 30, 1993
- 8 While offering franchise opportunities from 2002 to the present, The Cure Service Group, Inc., Rick Stonell aka Rick Stowell and Lisa Bongi failed to disclose a 1994 lawsuit filed in Contra Costa County, California for conversion and fraud that resulted in an adverse judgment on January 7, 1994.

Based upon the foregoing findings, the California Corporations Commissioner is of the opinion that Rick Stonell aka Rick Stowell, Lisa Bongi and The Cure Service Group, Inc., sold franchises in California that were subject to registration under the Franchise Investment Law without first being registered, in violation of Corporations Code section 31110 and failed to disclose the sale of five unregistered franchises in violation of Corporations Code section 31110.

Pursuant to section 31402 of the Corporations Code, Rick Stonell aka Rick Stowell, Lisa Bongi and The Cure Service Group, Inc. are hereby ordered to desist and refrain from the further offer or sale of franchises including but not limited to 1-800- Water Damage and Cure Water Damage franchises in California unless exempt.

This Order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and consistent with the purposes, policies and provisions of the Franchise Investment Law.
