	ORDER IMPOSING PENALTIES PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA FINANCIAL CODE SECTION 17408			

1	Pursuant to Financial Code section 17406, Excel Escrow was required to submit its audit		
2	report for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2006 to the Commissioner on or before April 16, 2007.		
3	The Commissioner notified Excel Escrow in writing on or about November 14, 2006 of the		
4	due date of the audit report as well as the possibility of the imposition of fines if the audit report was		
5	filed late.		
6	On or about May 10, 2007, the Commissioner again notified Excel Escrow in writing of the		
7	due date of the audit report and the possibility of the imposition of fines if the audit report was filed		
8	late.		
9	On September 5, 2007, Excel Escrow filed its audit report with the Commissioner, one		
10	hundred forty-one (141) days after the April 16, 2007 filing deadline.		
11	Financial Code section 17408, subdivisions (b) - (e) provide as follows:		
12	(b) The commissioner may impose, by order, a penalty on any person who fails within the time specified in any written demand of the commissioner (1)		
13	fails, within the time specified in any written demand of the commissioner, (1) to make and file with the commissioner any report required by law or		
14	requested by the commissioner The amount of the penalty may not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for each day for the first five days the report or		
15	information is overdue, and thereafter may not exceed five hundred dollars		
16	(\$500) for each day the report or information is overdue.		
17	(c) If, after an order has been made under subdivision (b), a request for hearing is filed in writing within 30 days of the date of service of the order by		
18	the person to whom the order was directed, a hearing shall be held in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 5 (commencing		
19	with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code,		
20	and the commissioner shall have all the powers granted under that chapter.		
21	(d) If the person fails to file a written request for a hearing within 30 days of the date of service of the order, the order imposing the penalty shall be		
22	deemed a final order of the commissioner, and the penalty shall be paid within		
23	five business days.
