24 Wayne Strumpfer, the Acting California Corporations Commissioner of the Department of
25 Corporations finds that:

26 Investors' Insight Asset Management ("Investors' Insight") has continued to violate the
27 books and records requirements of the Corporate Securities Law of 1968 (Corporations Code section
28 25000 et seq.) and the regulations enacted thereunder. Investors' Insight has violated California

1 Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.241.3 subdivision (a)(2) by failing to maintain general and
2 auxiliary ledgers. In addition, Investors' Insight violated California Code of Regulations, title 10,
3 section 260.241, subdivision (j) by failing to prepare and maintain monthly trial balances and
4 computations of net capital and aggregate indebtedness or of minimum net worth. Investors' Insight
5 has also violated California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.241.2, subdivision (a) by
6 failing to file annual financial reports with the Commissioner.

7 NOW, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, AND GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, it is hereby
8 ORDERED under the provisions of Corporations Code section 25249, that Investors' Insight
9 immediately discontinue violating California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 260.241.3,
10 subdivisions (a)(2) and (j) and section 260.241.2, subdivision (a).
