24	issued by PLATTE RIVER INSURANCE COMPANY in favor of JUST ESCROW expired and			
25	no replacement bond has been obtained.			
26	Based upon the foregoing, JUST ESCROW is conducting escrow business in violation of			
27	Section 17202 of the Financial Code and is conducting business in an unsafe and injurious manner

1 NOW, BASED ON THE FOREGOING, AND GOOD CAUSE APPEARING 2 THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED, under the provisions of Section 17415 of the California 3 Financial Code, that JUST ESCROW immediately discontinue acceptance of any new escrow or 4 joint control business, and of money, documents or other property in connection therewith. 5 THIS ORDER is to remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commissioner. б Section 17415 of the Financial Code provides as follows: 7 (a) If the commissioner, as a result of any examination or from any report made to him or her, shall find that any person subject to this 8 division is in an insolvent condition, is conducting business in such an unsafe or injurious manner as to render further operations hazardous to the 9 public or to customers, has failed to comply with the provisions of Section 10 17212.1 or 17414.1, has permitted its tangible net worth to be lower than the minimum required by law, has failed to maintain its liquid assets in 11 excess of current liabilities as set forth in Section 17210, or has failed to comply with the bonding requirements of Chapter 2 (commencing with 12 Section 17200) of this division, the commissioner may, by an order 13 addressed to and served by registered or certified mail or by personal service on such person and on any other person having in his or her 14 possession or control any escrowed funds, trust funds or other property deposited in escrow with said person, direct discontinuance of the 15 disbursement of trust funds by the parties or any of them, the receipt of 16 trust funds, the delivery or recording of documents received in escrow, or other business operations. No person having in his or her possession any of 17 these funds or documents shall be liable for failure to comply with the order unless he or she has written notice of the order. Subject to 18 subdivision (b), the order shall remain in effect until set aside by the 19 commissioner in whole or in part, the person has been adjudged bankrupt, or pursuant to Chapter 6 (commencing with Section 17621) of this division 20 the commissioner has assumed possession of the escrow agent. 21 Within 15 days from the date of any order pursuant to (b) 22 Subdivision (a), the person may request a hearing under the Administrative

Subdivision (a), the person may request a hearing under the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Division 3 or Title 2 of the Government Code. Upon receipt of a request, the matter shall be set for hearing to commence within 30 days after such receipt unless the person subject to this division consents to a later date. If no hearing is requested 15 days after the mailing or service of such notice and none is ordered by the commissioner, the failure to request a hearing shall constitute a waiver of the right to a hearing. Neither the request for a hearing nor the hearing itself shall stay the order issued by the commissioner under subdivision (a).
