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

 25 complaint, declarations and exhibits, and all other evidence presented, and having heard arguments
 26 of counsel, and good cause appearing therefor:

27 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Earl D. Anschultz ("Anschultz") and his partners,
 28 successors in interest, agents, employees, attorneys in fact, and all persons acting in concert or

1 participating with him, be and hereby are temporarily restrained and enjoined from, directly or
2 indirectly:

4 A. violating California Corporations Code section 25230 by acting as an investment adviser
5 without a license;

6 B. violating California Corporations Code section 25235(b) by engaging in transactions,
7 practices or a course of business to defraud or deceive any client or prospective client;

8 C. violating the Desist and Refrain Order, dated April 26, 2001;

9 D. violating the Stipulated Bar Order issued on October 1, 2005; and

10 E. removing, destroying, mutilating, concealing, altering, transferring, or otherwise
11 disposing of, in any manner, any books, records, computer programs, computer files, computer
12 printouts, correspondence, brochures, manuals, or other writings or documents of any kind as
13 defined in California Evidence Code Section 250 relating to the transactions and course of conduct
14 as alleged in the complaint, unless authorized by this Court.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Temporary Restraining Order shall expire ^{on} ~~at~~ 12-23-05
16 ~~at 12:00 p.m.~~ at 12:00 p.m., 2005, unless, for good cause shown, it is extended or
17 unless the parties against whom it is directed consent that it may be extended for a longer period.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that at 9:30 (a.m.) ~~p.m.~~ on 12-23,
20 2005, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, Defendant Anschultz shall appear in
21 **Department 85** in the above entitled Court, located at the Stanley Mosk Court House, 111 North
22 Hill Street, Los Angeles, California to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be
23 granted enjoining Defendant Anschultz and his partners, successors in interest, agents, employees,
24 attorneys in fact, and all persons acting in concert or participating with him, from directly or
