27 Petitioner, Mega Capital Funding, Inc. (“Mega Capital”) having filed a petition for  
28 reinstatement of its California Residential Mortgage Lending Act license, which was revoked by the  
California Corporations Commissioner (“Commissioner”) on August 20, 2009 to be effective

1 September 11, 2009, the petition having been considered, no further argument submitted, and good  
2 cause appearing,

3 IT IS ORDERED that, subject to the Commissioner’s satisfactory review, the Petition for  
4 Reinstatement is granted provided that the following conditions are met by Mega Capital within  
5 thirty (30) of the date hereof:

6 1. Payment of penalties in the amount of \$319.63, which represents 1% of the unpaid  
7 assessment for each month or part of a month that the Assessment Invoice Number CF1781  
8 remained unpaid. Invoice Number CF1781 was due and payable on June 20, 2009, but was not paid  
9 until March 10, 2011.

10 2. Payment of penalties in the amount of \$500.00 for failure to timely notify the  
11 California Corporations Commissioner of the change of business location. Mega Capital is credited  
12 \$300.00 towards this penalty for the payment of a new finance lender license application when a  
13 license reinstatement petition was required.

14 3. Submission of a current surety bond meeting the requirements of Financial Code  
15 section 22112.

16 4. Verification of the company’s good standing with the California Secretary of State.

17 5. Submission of a balance sheet for the most recent month end reflecting compliance  
18 with the net worth requirements of Financial Code section 22104.

19 6. A current listing of the officers, director and control persons for Mega Capital.

20 7. Submission of proof that Mega Capital has not engaged in finance lending and/or  
21 brokering in the State of California since September 11, 2009 or if so, under what authority that  
22 activity was conducted.
