	The conservator, pursuant to Financial Code section 17630, shall have all the rights, powers,

pertinent bank and escrow records of Morris Escrow. These rights, powers and privileges shall

include all acts as are necessary or expedient to collect, conserve and protect the trust accounts and pertinent bank and escrow records of Morris Escrow, including (a) the collection, recovery and compromise of claims, deeds, property and rights in favor of or belonging to Morris Escrow regarding the trust account(s); (b) the execution of all deeds, conveyances, agreements, compliances and instruments of every kind and nature in connection with the trust accounts and pertinent bank and escrow records of Morris Escrow; (c) the employment of accountants and attorneys to the extent reasonably necessary; and (d) with prior consent of the California Corporations Commissioner, the institution, maintenance and defense of suits related to the affairs of Morris Escrow, the filing of petitions or applications in court or elsewhere with respect to the trust accounts and pertinent bank and escrow records of Morris Escrow, for all purposes.

All expenses of the Conservatorship shall be paid out of the assets of Morris Escrow, if any shall exist, and shall be a lien thereon which shall be prior to any other lien.

This Order is effective on the date hereof and may be amended or terminated upon further order of the California Corporations Commissioner.
