26 Petitioner, Numerica Mortgage, LLC (“Numerica”), having filed a petition for reinstatement  
27 of its California Residential Mortgage Lending Act license, which was revoked by the California  
28 Corporations Commissioner (“Commissioner”) on December 1, 2006, the petition having been  
considered, further argument having been submitted by Numerica, and good cause appearing,

1 IT IS ORDERED that, subject to the Commissioner’s satisfactory review, the Petition for  
2 Reinstatement is granted provided the following conditions are met within thirty days (30) of the  
3 date hereof:

- 4 1. Payment of Assessment Invoice Number MB0292 in the amount of \$5,000.
- 5 2. Payment of penalties in the amount of \$50.00 for each month or part of a month that  
6 the Assessment Invoice Number MB0292 remained unpaid, which invoice was due and payable on  
7 October 19, 2006, or \$1,800.00, if paid by the end of August 2009, otherwise, penalties will continue  
8 to accrue at \$50.00 for each month or part of a month that the assessment remains unpaid.
- 9 3. Submission of a surety bond meeting the requirements of Financial Code section  
10 50205.
- 11 4. Submission of audited financial statements for the fiscal year ended December 31,  
12 2008 reflecting compliance with the tangible net worth requirements of Financial Code section  
13 50201.
- 14 5. Submission of evidence that Numerica is authorized to conduct business in the State  
15 of California.
- 16 6. Compliance with all other licensing requirements of the California Residential  
17 Mortgage Lending Act, including submission of all necessary information and/or documentation  
18 regarding any material change(s) in the information contained in its initial application for licensure  
19 and any post-license amendments previously filed with the Commissioner, including, without  
20 limitation, the plan of operation and officers, directors, and shareholders owning 10% or more of the  
21 interests of Petitioner.
- 22 7. Submission of proof that Petitioner has not engaged in residential mortgage lending  
23 and/or residential mortgage loan servicing in the State of California since December 1, 2006 or if so,  
24 under what authority that activity was conducted.
