22 THE COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FINDS

24 THAT:

25 Pursuant to California Financial Code section 17406, R & R ESCROW, INC. (“R & R  
26 Escrow”) was required to submit its annual audit report for fiscal year ended May 31, 2006 to the  
27 California Corporations Commissioner (“Commissioner”) on or before September 15, 2006.  
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1           On or about April 10, 2006, R & R Escrow was notified in writing of the due date of the  
2 annual audit report, as well as the possibility of the imposition of fines if the annual audit report was  
3 filed late. However, R & R Escrow failed to file its annual audit report for fiscal year ended May 31,  
4 2006 until November 13, 2006 — fifty-nine (59) days late.  
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6           California Financial Code section 17408(b) – (e) provides as follows:

7           (b) The commissioner may impose, by order, a penalty on any person  
8 who fails, within the time specified in any written demand of the  
9 commissioner, (1) to make and file with the commissioner any report  
10 required by law or requested by the commissioner . . . The amount of  
11 the penalty may not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for each day  
12 for the first five days the report or information is overdue, and  
13 thereafter may not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) for each day the  
14 report or information is overdue.

15           (c) If, after an order has been made under subdivision (b), a request for  
16 hearing is filed in writing within 30 days of the date of the service of  
17 the order by the person to whom the order was directed, a hearing shall  
18 be held in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter  
19 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2  
20 of the Government Code, and the commissioner shall have all the  
21 powers granted under that chapter.

22           (d) If the person fails to file a written request for a hearing within 30  
23 days of the date of service of the order, the order imposing penalty  
24 shall be deemed a final order of the commissioner, and the penalty  
25 shall be paid within five business days.

26           (e) If a hearing is requested, the penalty shall be paid within five  
27 business days after the effective date of any decision in the case  
28 ordering payment to be paid.

          NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioner having found that R & R Escrow failed to file its  
annual audit report by the September 15, 2006 due date, and instead filed the report on November  
13, 2006, R & R ESCROW, INC. is hereby ordered, pursuant to Financial Code section 17408, to  
pay to the Commissioner the sum of \$27,500.
