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DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER

This order is issued for the reason that, in the opinion of the Commissioner of Corporations of the State of California, the sale of such Securities is subject to the qualification under said law and such Securities are being or have been offered for sale without first being so qualified. The Commissioner of Corporations of the State of California finds that this Order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and consistent with the purposes, policies and provisions of the Corporate Securities Law of 1968.
