RECITALS

| A. Sage Credit Escrow, Inc. (hereinafter, "Sage") is an escrow agent licensed by the |
|---|
| Commissioner pursuant to the Escrow Law of the State of California (California Financial Cod |
| Section 17000, et seq.) Sage currently holds escrow agent's license number 963-2086 with its |
| principal place of business located at 8001 Irvine Center Drive, Suite 220, Irvine, CA 92618. |

- B. On or about March 26, 2008, the California Corporations Commissioner ("Commissioner") issued an Order Imposing Penalties pursuant to the California Financial Code section 17408 ("Order"). The Order imposed penalties in the amount "of \$19,300, plus an additional \$100 a day for each day after March 26, 2008 that the annual audit report is not filed" due to Sage's failure to timely file its annual audit report in violation of California Financial Code section 17406.
- C. On or about March 26, 2008, the Commissioner issued a Notice of Intention to Issue Order Suspending Escrow Agent's License pursuant to the California Financial Code section 17608, Accusation, and accompanying documents. The Commissioner notified Sage of his intention to suspend Sage's agent license "until such time as Respondent files its audit report for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2007, or for a period of one month, whichever is greater."
- E. The Order Imposing Penalties, Notice of Intention to Issue Order Suspending Escrow Agent's License, Accusation and accompanying documents were served on Sage no later than May 16, 2008. Sage eventually filed the annual audit report along with its request for a hearing on the Commissioner's Order on May 20, 2008.
- F. The Office of Administrative Hearings set those matters for a 9:00 a.m. hearing on August 20, 2008.
- G. On the morning of the hearing, the parties entered into a settlement agreement wherein Sage admitted the allegations contained in the Order, Sage agreed that the Order would be deemed a final order, and Sage Escrow acknowledged penalties in the amount of \$24,600. As full settlement of the Order, Sage promised to pay the Commissioner the sum of \$24,600 in penalties, as follows:
 - \$2000 by the close of business on September 15, 2008;
 - \$2000 by the close of business on October 15, 2008;
 - \$2000 by the close of business on November 15, 2008;
