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19	The California Corporations Commissioner ("Commissioner") finds:
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21	Respondent Francisco J. Tejeda/Valentina Tejeda doing business as Common Cents
22	("Common Cents") is a deferred deposit transaction originator licensed by the California
23	Corporations Commissioner ("Commissioner") pursuant to the California Deferred Deposit
24	Transaction Law (California Financial Code § 23000 et seq.) ("CDDTL").
25	2. Pursuant to California Financial Code section 23013, all CDDTL licensees are
26	required to maintain a surety bond in the minimum amount of \$25,000.00. The surety bond of
27	Common Cents expired on May 19, 2009. On or about April 21, 2009, the Commissioner notified
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Common Cents that a replacement surety bond had to be filed immediately, but no later than the expiration date to avoid suspension or revocation of its CDDTL license.

- 3. Common Cents has not obtained a replacement surety bond in violation of California Financial Code section 23013.
- 4. Failure to maintain a surety bond is grounds under Financial Code section 23052 for the revocation of a license issued under the CDDTL.
- 5. On May 20, 2009, the Commissioner issued a Notice of Intention to Issue Order Revoking CDDTL License, Accusation, accompanying documents against Common Cents based upon the above, and Common Cents was served with those documents by certified mail, return receipt on or about May 22, 2009.

NOW GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the CDDTL license issued to Common Cents is hereby revoked. This order is effective as of the date hereof.
