21	Commissioner of Business Oversight ("Commissioner") on February 2, 2015,		
22	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT United and any and all officers, directors, employees,		
23	independent contractors, or agents operating on behalf of United and their successors or assigns		
24	immediately discontinue:		
25	1. Disbursing dormant trust funds to anyone other than the person or entity to which th		
26	funds are due and owing in violation of Financial Code section 17414(a)(1) and California Code of		
27	Regulations, title 10, sections 1738 and 1738.2.		
28	2. Disbursing unauthorized fees to	itself in violation of Financial Code section	

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17414(a)(1) and California Code of Regulations, title 10, sections 1738 and 1738.2 either by way of overstating vendor invoices on closing statements and/or cancelation instructions in violation of Financial Code section 17414(a)(2) or otherwise.

3. The violation of Financial Code section 17404 and California Code of Regulations, title 10, section 1732.2 by failing to reconcile on a monthly basis the separate trust account United maintains for trust funds that are or will become due for escheatment to the State Controller under the provisions of the Unclaimed Property Law (Code of Civil Procedure §1500 et seq.).

This Order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of consumers and is consistent with the purposes, policies and provisions of the Escrow Law. This Order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Commissioner.
