26	Pursuant to Financial Code section 17406, Whittier Escrow, Inc. ("Whittier Escrow") was		
27	required to submit its annual audit report for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 ("2008		
28	audit report") to the Commissioner on or before January 15, 2009.		

On or about August 11, 2008, the Commissioner notified Whittier Escrow in writing that its 2008 audit report was due January 15, 2009. Whittier Escrow failed to file the 2008 audit report by January 15, 2009.

On or about February 19, 2009, a follow-up letter was sent via certified mail to Nancy Ruiz, the president of Whittier Escrow, concerning Whittier Escrow's failure to file the 2008 audit report. Whittier Escrow was notified that a failure to file the 2008 audit report would result in Whittier Escrow being assessed \$100 per day for each day the 2008 audit report is overdue, in addition to a potential special examination, suspension and/or revocation of its escrow agent's license. This letter was certified as delivered on February 23, 2009.

Whittier Escrow has still not filed its 2008 audit report as required by Financial Code section 17406.

Financial Code section 17408, subdivisions (b) – (e), provides as follows:

- (b) The commissioner may impose, by order, a penalty on any person who fails, within the time specified in any written demand of the commissioner, (1) to make and file with the commissioner any report required by law or requested by the commissioner... The amount of the penalty may not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for each day for the first five days the report or information is overdue and, thereafter may not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) for each day the report or information is overdue.
- (c) If, after an order has been made under subdivision (b), a request for hearing is filed in writing within 30 days of the date of service of the order by the person to whom the order was directed, a hearing shall be held in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, and the commissioner shall have all the powers granted under that chapter.
- (d) If the person fails to file a written request for a hearing within 30 days of the date of service of the order, the order imposing the penalty shall be deemed a final order of the commissioner, and the penalty shall be paid within five business days.
- (e) If a hearing is requested, the penalty shall be paid within five business days after the effective date of any decision in the case ordering payment to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioner having found that Whittier Escrow failed to timely file its annual audit report containing audited financial statements for its fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 as required by Financial Code section 17406, Whittier Escrow, Inc. is hereby ordered, pursuant to Financial Code section 17408, to pay to the Commissioner the sum of \$100 per day beginning ten (10) days from February 19, 2009, or March 2, 2009, totaling \$23,000 as of the date of this Order, and an additional \$100 per day until the 2008 audit report is filed.
