**RESCISSION OF DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER**  
**(For violations of sections 22100, 22161, and 50002 of the California Financial Code)**

Pursuant to sections 22712 and 50320 of the California Financial Code, the California Corporations Commissioner (Commissioner) hereby rescinds his Desist and Refrain Order issued on April 16, 2008 as to Sharon Baker only. The Order, pertaining to the unlicensed lending activity of C.L.C. BancGroup, Inc. and C.L.C. Bank (“C.L.C.”) through the website www.citiloanz.com, in violation of sections 22100 and 22161 of the California Finance Lenders Law and section 50002 the California Residential Mortgage Lending Act, remains in effect as to all other persons and/or entities named.

Based on information received after the issuance of the April 16, 2008 Order, the Commissioner is satisfied that Sharon Baker is not now and has never been associated with C.L.C. The Commissioner is satisfied that Sharon Baker’s identity was used without her consent by an unknown person(s) creating a fictitious relationship between Sharon Baker and C.L.C.

The Commissioner finds that the rescission of this Order as to Sharon Baker is necessary and appropriate in the public interest and for the protection of investors, consistent with the purposes of
