20	The Complaint, the Commissioner of Business Oversight (Commissioner), of the				
21	Department of Business Oversight (Department), finds the following:				
22	I.				
23	<u>Jurisdiction and Venue</u>				
24	1. The Commissioner is authorized to administer and enforce the provisions of the				
25	Franchise Investment Law (Corp. Code § 31000 et seq.) (FIL) and the rules and regulations				
26	promulgated thereunder which control the registration, offer and sale of franchises in California.				
27	2. The Commissioner brings this action pursuant to the provisions of the FIL, and the				
28	rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, in	ncluding Corporations Code sections 31303, 31304

II. Statement of Facts

- 3. At all relevant times, Classic Rock Coffee Co. Franchising LLC (Classic Rock) is a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, on or around August 2, 2012, with a principal place of business at 1900 West Sunset, Suite A116, Springfield, Missouri 65807.
- 4. Classic Rock offers franchisees the opportunity to operate a Classic Rock Coffee Co. store selling "coffee drinks, protein shakes, smoothies, pastries, soups, salads, and sandwiches, equipment, apparel, and related merchandise."
- 5. From December 2013 to present, Classic Rock was registered with the Department to offer and sell franchises in California.
- 6. At all relevant times, Kent Morrison (Morrison) was the Managing Member of Classic Rock, with a principal place of business at 1900 West Sunset, Suite A116, Springfield, Missouri 65807.
- 7. At all relevant times, Brett Payne (Payne) was the Director of Franchise Operations of Classic Rock, with a principal place of business at 1900 West Sunset, Suite A116, Springfield, Missouri 65807.
- 8. On or about September 4, 2018, the Department requested that Classic Rock disclose all franchises that it had offered and sold in California from December 2013 to present.
- 9. By September 25, 2018, Classic Rock disclosed to the Department that it had offered and sold two franchises in California.
- 10. On or about January 12, 2016, AM, a prospective franchisee, completed a "Confidential Franchise Application" with Classic Rock.
- 11. On or about January 12, 2016, Classic Rock, through Payne, emailed AM a link to Classic Rock's "Franchise Disclosure Document."
- 12. On or about January 13, 2016, Payne on behalf of Classic Rock, sent AM a document entitled "CRCC FDD Disclosures History."

- 13. The "CRCC FDD Disclosures History" stated it included a "signed Disclosure Document dated December 11, 2013." But in fact, no franchise disclosure document (FDD) was attached.
- 14. The "CRCC FDD Disclosures History" that AM received from Payne contained only the 2013 Confidentiality Agreement and a Receipt with an issuance date of December 11, 2013.
- 15. AM "echo signed" the 2013 Confidentiality Agreement and Receipt on January 12, 2016. However, AM was unaware that she did not receive the complete FDD.
- 16. On or around March 17, 2017, AM signed a franchise agreement with Classic Rock and paid the initial franchise fee of \$39,000.00.
- 17. AM did not receive the effective 2016 FDD prior to signing the franchise agreement and paying Classic Rock the initial franchise fee.
- 18. Prior to signing the franchise agreement and paying the initial franchise free on March 7, 2017, AM should have received from Classic Rock the 2016 FDD. The 2016 FDD was effective from June 7, 2016 through April 20, 2017.
- 19. AM believed the documents Classic Rock gave her on or about January 12, 2016 was in fact the completed FDD. AM signed a franchise agreement that included a "Franchise Compliance Certificate" which stated AM received the FDD, reviewed and understood it.
- 20. Classic Rock misrepresented to AM that she received the FDD in the "CRCC FDD Disclosures History," when in fact she only received the Confidentiality Agreement and Receipt.
- 21. Classic Rock proffered to AM the Franchise Compliance Certificate as evidence that it gave AM the FDD. As a result, AM unknowingly believed she received the 2016 FDD when she did not.

III. Citations and Desist and Refrain Order

Failure to Provide a Franchise Disclosure Document to a Franchisee

- 22. Corporations Code section 31119, subdivision (a) states:
 - (a) It is unlawful to sell any franchise in this state that is subject to registration under this law without first providing to the prospective franchisee, at least 14 days prior to the execution by the prospective

franchisee of any binding franchise or other agreement, or at least 14 days prior to the receipt of any consideration, whichever occurs first, a copy of the franchise disclosure document, together with a copy of all proposed agreements relating to the sale of the franchise.

23. Corporations Code section 31402 states, in relevant part:

If, in the opinion of the commissioner, the offer of any franchise is subject to registration under this law and it is being, or it has been, offered for sale without the offer first being registered, the commissioner may order the franchisor or offeror of that franchise to desist and refrain from the further offer or sale of that franchise unless and until the offer has been duly registered under this law

- 24. Corporations Code section 31406 states, in relevant part:
 - (a) If, upon inspection or investigation, based upon a complaint or otherwise, the commissioner has cause to believe that a person is violating any provision of this division or any rule or order promulgated pursuant to this division, the commissioner may issue a citation to that person in writing describing with particularity the basis of the citation. Each citation may contain an order to desist and refrain and an assessment of an administrative penalty not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) per violation and shall contain reference to this section, including the provisions of subdivision (c). All penalties collected under this section shall be deposited in the State Corporations Fund.
 - (b) The sanctions authorized under this section shall be separate from, and in addition to, all other administrative, civil, or criminal remedies.
 - (c) If within 60 days from the receipt of the citation, the person cited fails to notify the commissioner that the person intends to request a hearing as described in subdivision (d), the citation shall be deemed final
- 25. Prior to March 7, 2017, Classic Rock failed to provide the required copy of the 2016 FDD to a California franchisee before the execution of the franchise agreement or receiving consideration from franchisee.
- 26. Based upon the foregoing findings, the Commissioner is of the opinion that Classic Rock failed to provide the required FDD, in violation of Corporations Code section 31119. Pursuant to Corporations Code sections 31402 and 31406, Classic Rock Coffee Co. Franchising LLC is

hereby cited and ordered to desist and refrain from failing to give franchise disclosure documents to franchisees within the time prescribed by Corporations Code section 31119.

27. This order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and franchisees and consistent with the purposes, policies and provisions of the FIL.

Omission of a Material Fact to Franchisee

28. Corporations Code section 31201 states:

It is unlawful for any person to offer or sell a franchise in this state by means of any written or oral communication not enumerated in Section 31200 which includes an untrue statement of a material fact or omits to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading.

- 29. During the period of March 2017, Classic Rock offered and sold a franchise agreement in this state by means of a written or oral communication which included an untrue statement of a material fact or omitted to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading, by failing to disclose the franchisee that she did not receive the then effective 2016 FDD.
- 30. When Classic Rock provided the "Franchise Compliance Certificate" to AM, she completed and signed the certification that AM received, carefully reviewed and understood the FDD. Classic Rock did not attempt to correct franchisee's belief that she was provided with the requisite FDD. Classic Rock, the franchisor, misled franchisee in her misguided belief despite knowing that AM had not actually receive the 2016 FDD.
- 31. Based upon the foregoing findings, the Commissioner is of the opinion that Classic Rock engaged in the offer and sale of franchises in this state by means of written or oral communications which included an untrue statement of a material fact or omit to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading, in violation of Corporations Code section 31201. Pursuant to Corporations Code sections 31402 and 31406, Classic Rock Coffee Co. Franchising LLC is hereby cited and ordered to desist and refrain from further offer or sale of franchises by means of written or oral communications which include an untrue statement of material fact or omit to state a material

fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading.

32. This order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and franchisees and consistent with the purposes, policies and provisions of the FIL.

IV. Administrative Penalties

- 33. Corporations Code section 31406 states, in relevant part:
 - (a) If, upon inspection or investigation, based upon a complaint or otherwise, the commissioner has cause to believe that a person is violating any provision of this division or any rule or order promulgated pursuant to this division, the commissioner may issue a citation to that person in writing describing with particularity the basis of the citation. Each citation may contain an order to desist and refrain and an assessment of an administrative penalty not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) per violation and shall contain reference to this section, including the provisions of subdivision (c). All penalties collected under this section shall be deposited in the State Corporations Fund.
 - (b) The sanctions authorized under this section shall be separate from, and in addition to, all other administrative, civil, or criminal remedies.
 - (c) If within 60 days from the receipt of the citation, the person cited fails to notify the commissioner that the person intends to request a hearing as described in subdivision (d), the citation shall be deemed final.
 - (d) Any hearing under this section shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.
 - (e) After the exhaustion of the review procedures provided for in this Section, the commissioner may apply to the appropriate superior court for a judgment in the amount of the administrative penalty and other compelling the cited person to comply with the order of the commissioner. The application shall include a certified copy of the final order of the commissioner and shall constitute a sufficient showing to warrant the issuance of the judgment and order.

34. Pursuant to Corporations Code section 31406, Classic Rock Coffee Co. Franchising
LLC is hereby ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$2,500.00 for each failure to provide a
franchise disclosure document prior to the sale of a franchise and for failing to disclose a material
fact to a franchisee, for a total amount of \$5,000.00. The administrative penalty in the amount of
\$5,000.00 shall be paid in the form of a cashier's check payable to the "Department of Business
Oversight" and transmitted to the attention of: Accounting, at the Department of Business Oversight
located at 1515 K Street, Suite 200, Sacramento, California, 95814. Notice of the payment shall
concurrently be sent to the attention of Vanessa T. Lu, Counsel, Enforcement Division, 320 West 4th
Street, Suite 750, Los Angeles, California 90013-2344.

35. If within 60 days from the receipt of the Citation, Classic Rock Coffee Co. Franchising LLC fails to notify the Commissioner that it intends to request a hearing as described in Corporations Code section 31406, subdivision (d), this Citation shall be deemed final.

V. Ancillary Relief

36. Corporations Code section 31408 provides, in relevant part:

(a) If the commissioner determines it is in the public interest, the commissioner may include in any administrative action brought under this division, including a stop order, a claim for ancillary relief, including, but not limited to, a claim for rescission, restitution or disgorgement or damages on behalf of the persons injured by the act or practice consulting the subject matter of the action, and the administrative law judge shall have jurisdiction to award additional relief. The person affected may be required to attend remedial education, as directed by the commissioner.
