

ADDENDUM TO THE FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS AND UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST

The Final Statement of Reasons and Updated Informative Digest is updated as described below.

1. During review of this regulatory action by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), OAL discovered that the original section numbering of the regulations from sections 2032-2057 could not be used, as sections 2049-2057 are already being used by the Department of Insurance in Title 10 of the California Code of Regulations. The Department determined the best solution to this issue was to renumber all of the regulations from 2032-2044.5.
2. During OAL review of the regulations, the Department made nonsubstantive grammatical, punctuation, and technical changes to the regulations. These include the following:
 - a. Updated internal cross references within the regulations to accurately reference the new section numbers.
 - b. Removed text in section 2032(a)(7), (8), and (9) and in section 2039(b) (formerly section 2046(b)), after references to the four incorporated by reference forms, that had embedded internet links to each form, as this text would be unusable and unclear in the California Code of Regulations.
 - c. Added cross references to Financial Code section 20114(e) and the regulation section 2034.5 (formerly section 2037) in section 2035.5(d) (formerly section 2039(d)) to clarify fees payable for fingerprinting.
 - d. Revised subdivision numbering under section 2041(c)(2) (formerly section 2050(c)(2)) from (i), (ii), and (iii) to (A), (B), and (C).

The Department's changes to the regulations are all non-substantive changes without regulatory effect. The changes renumber the regulations, revise structure, syntax, grammar, punctuation, or making the technical changes described above. None of the changes to the regulations materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription or other regulatory element of the regulations.
