# Guide for out of state banks to do business in California:

Following is a quick reference guide for out-of-state banks that want to do business in California, with links to forms and relevant code sections.

## If there will be no brick-and-mortar office in this state

An out of state bank may need to qualify as a foreign corporation with the California Secretary of State, pursuant to Chapter 21 of the California Corporations Code, commencing with <u>section 2100</u>. For more information, visit the Secretary of State website at <u>www.sos.ca.gov</u> or call (916) 653-6814. No approval from or notice to the Department of Financial Protection and Innovation (DFPI) is required.

## If there will be a brick-and-mortar office in this state:

**Branch office:** Qualification as a foreign corporation with the California Secretary of State pursuant to Chapter 21 of the California Corporations Code, commencing with <u>section 2100 may be necessary</u>. For more information, visit the Secretary of State website at <u>www.sos.ca.gov</u> or call (916) 653-6814.

Notify DFPI of the establishment of the office within 10 business days, as described in Financial Code <u>section 1082</u>.

### Facility - insured bank (e.g., loan production office)

Qualification as a foreign corporation with the California Secretary of State pursuant to Chapter 21 of the California Corporations Code, commencing with <u>section 2100 may be necessary</u>. For more information, visit the Secretary of State website at <u>www.sos.ca.gov</u> or call (916) 653-6814.

File form <u>DFPI-55 Appointment of the Commissioner of Business Oversight as Attorney for Service of</u> <u>Process</u>. File a report stating the name of the bank, location of the facility, facility manager's name and contact information not less than 30 days before establishment.

### Facility - non-insured bank (e.g., trust company):

Qualification as a foreign corporation with the California Secretary of State pursuant to Chapter 21 of the California Corporations Code, commencing with <u>section 2100 may be necessary</u>. File form <u>DFPI-55 Appointment of the Commissioner of Business Oversight as Attorney for Service of</u> <u>Process</u>.

File an application providing documentation that will allow the Commissioner to make a positive finding of the factors listed in Financial Code <u>section 1713</u>. In the application, Please state the name of the bank, location of the facility, facility manager's name and contact information.
