25 Petitioner Lending Resources Group, Inc. (Lending Resources) filed a Petition for  
26 Reinstatement of its California Financing Law license (Petition) pursuant to Government Code  
27 section 11522 on or about April 1, 2019.

28 On June 18, 2019, the Commissioner of Business Oversight (Commissioner) notified the

1 Attorney General of California of the filing of the Petition and gave the parties until July 22, 2019, to  
2 present further argument.

3 On August 14, 2019, the Commissioner granted the Petition on the condition that Lending  
4 Resources pay a \$2,000.00 penalty within 45 days of the date of the order.

5 The Commissioner finds that Lending Resources has complied with the condition of  
6 reinstatement of its license and is otherwise fit to engage in the business of brokering.

7 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is granted and the California Financing  
8 Law license of Lending Resources Group, Inc. (Lic. No. 60DBO-74334) is reinstated.
