19 On January 6, 2020, Landmark Wall RR Ltd. (Landmark), filed with the Commissioner of
20 Financial Protection and Innovation a petition for reinstatement (Petition) of its California
21 Financing Law (CFL) license. The Commissioner had revoked the CFL license of Landmark on
22 December 27, 2018, after it failed to pay its annual assessment as required under Financial Code
23 section 22107.

24 On April 23, 2021, the Commissioner notified the Attorney General of the filing of the
25 Petition and gave the parties until May 3, 2021, to present any written argument or supporting
26 documentation.

27 On May 13, 2021, the Commissioner granted the Petition on the condition that Landmark do
28 the following no later than 14 days after the date of the order:

1 1. Pay a \$2,500.00 penalty for failing to pay the annual assessment in violation of
2 Financial Code section 22107.

3 2. Pay the \$250.00 annual assessment for 2018–2019.

4 The Commissioner finds that Landmark has complied with all conditions for reinstatement
5 of its license and is otherwise fit to engage in the business of finance lending or brokering.

6 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is granted and Landmark’s CFL license is
7 reinstated, effective as of the date of this Order.
