21	On March 19, 2020, WKS Lending, LLC (WKS Lending) filed with the Commissioner of		
22	Financial Protection and Innovation a petition for reinstatement (Petition) of its California		
23	Financing Law (CFL) license. In an order that became effective on December 27, 2018, the		
24	Commissioner revoked WKS's CFL license because it failed to pay its annual assessment as		
25	required under Financial Code section 22107.		
26	On April 19, 2021, the Commissioner notified the Attorney General of the filing of the		

Petition and gave the parties until May 3, 2021, to present any written argument or supporting

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On May 10, 2021, the Commissioner granted the Petition on the condition that WKS Lending did the following no later than 14 days after the date of the Order:

- 1. Pay the \$250.00 annual assessment for 2018–2019.
- 2. Pay a \$2,500.00 penalty for failing to pay the annual assessment in violation of Financial Code section 22107.
- Pay a \$2,500.00 penalty for each of the 12 loans it made while unlicensed in 3. violation of Financial Code section 22100, subdivision (a), for a total of \$30,000.00.

The Commissioner finds that WKS Lending has complied with all conditions for reinstatement of its license and is otherwise fit to engage in the business of finance lending or brokering.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is granted and WKS Lending's CFL license is reinstated, effective as of the date of this Order.
