22 On April 15, 2021, Chicago Mortgage Solutions Corporation (Chicago Mortgage) filed with  
23 the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation (Commissioner) a petition for  
24 reinstatement of its California Financing Law (CFL) license. The Commissioner revoked the CFL  
25 license of Chicago Mortgage on December 27, 2017, after it failed to pay its annual assessment as  
26 required under Financial Code section 22107.

27 The petition having been considered, no further argument submitted, and good cause  
28 appearing,

1 IT IS ORDERED that, subject to the Commissioner’s satisfactory review, Chicago  
2 Mortgage’s petition for reinstatement of its CFL license is granted provided that the following  
3 conditions are met by Chicago Mortgage on or before August 6, 2021:

- 4 1. Payment of penalties in the amount \$2,500.00; and
- 5 2. Payment of the annual assessment for the fiscal year 2017–2018 in the amount of  
6 \$250.00.
