23 On June 30, 2021, Jayco Premium Finance of California, Inc. (Jayco), filed with the
24 Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation (Commissioner) a petition (Petition) for
25 reinstatement of its California Financing Law (CFL) license. The Commissioner revoked Jayco's CFL
26 license on April 19, 2017, after it failed to filed its annual report required under Financial Code section
27 22159.

28 On September 9, 2021, the Commissioner notified the Attorney General of the filing of the

Petition and gave the parties until September 23, 2021, to present any written argument or supporting documentation.

On October 5, 2021, the Commissioner granted the Petition on the condition that Jayco performed the following no later than November 5, 2021:

- (1) Provide an address change form to the Commissioner;
- (2) Provide a surety bond rider with Jayco’s new address or a new surety bond with current address information; and
- (3) Pay a penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00.

The Commissioner finds that Jayco has complied with all conditions for reinstatement of its license and is otherwise fit to engage in the business of finance lending or brokering.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is granted and Jayco’s CFL license is reinstated, effective as of the date of this order.
