21 On or about January 15, 2021, Huma Capital Management LLC (HCM) filed with the
22 Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation (Commissioner) a petition for reinstatement
23 of its California Financing Law (CFL) license. In an order dated April 3, 2019, the Commissioner
24 revoked HCM’s CFL license because it failed to file its annual report as required under
25 Financial Code section 22159.

26 On October 11, 2021, the Commissioner notified the Attorney General of the filing of the
27 Petition and gave the parties until November 12, 2021, to present any written argument or
28 supporting documentation.

1 The Commissioner, having considered the Petition and arguments of the parties under
2 Government Code section 11522, finds that HCM has presented sufficient evidence showing that it
3 has rehabilitated and is otherwise fit to engage in the business of finance lending or brokering.

4 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is granted on the condition that no later
5 than 14 days after the date of this Order, HCM pays a \$2,500.00 penalty for failing to file the annual
6 report in violation of Financial Code section 22159.

7 The total amount of \$2,500.00 shall be paid by cashier’s check or Automated Clearing
8 House deposit made payable to the Department of Financial Protection and Innovation and
9 transmitted to the attention of Accounting – Litigation at the Department of Financial Protection
10 and Innovation, 2101 Arena Boulevard, Sacramento, California 95834. Notice of the payment must
11 be sent to Taylor Steinbacher, Senior Counsel, 320 West 4th Street, Suite 750, Los Angeles,
