25	1. Providence Escrow, Inc. (Providence), a California corporation, was an escrow agent		
26	licensed by the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation, formerly the Commissioner		
	of Business Oversight (Commissioner), pursuant to the Escrow Law of the State of California (Fin.

2. On or about July 29, 2014, the Commissioner appointed former Corporations		
Examiner and current Special Administrator, Escrow Licensing, Paul Liang (Liang) to take		
possession of the bank and escrow records of Providence in order that such records could be		
maintained for the five-year retention period mandated by the Escrow Law. Liang was appointed		
conservator over the records of Providence after a receivership action over Providence had been		
concluded, but the time period to retain the bank and escrow records had yet to elapse. Liang tool		
possession of the bank and escrow records of Providence on or about January 16, 2015.		

3. The five-year retention period for maintaining the bank and escrow records of Providence elapsed on June 23, 2019, and the Department of Financial Protection and Innovation, formerly, the Department of Business Oversight has not received any requests for records since 2015. Accordingly, on August 17, 2021, the bank and escrow records for Providence were destroyed.

Now, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- The conservatorship over the books and records of Providence Escrow, Inc. is hereby terminated pursuant to Financial Code section 17634.
- 2. The Commissioner hereby ratifies those actions taken by the Conservator with respect to the records, and the Conservator, the State of California and each of their respective employees and agents is hereby released from any and all obligations and/or liability arising out of or relating to the conservatorship of Providence Escrow, Inc.
