California Financing Law (CFL) license. The Commissioner had revoked the CFL license of 2 JMP on December 30, 2019, after it failed to pay the 2019-2020 annual assessment pursuant to 3 Financial Code section 22107.

On September 22, 2021, the Commissioner notified the Attorney General of the filing of the Petition and gave the parties until October 27, 2021, to present any written argument or supporting documentation.

The Commissioner, after considering JMP's Petition and arguments of the parties under Government Code section 11522, determined that JMP presented sufficient evidence showing it has paid its 2019-2020 annual assessment and is otherwise fit to engage in the business of finance lending or brokering.

On December 9, 2021, the Commissioner issued an Order Conditionally Granting Petition for Reinstatement to JMP dated December 9, 2021 (Conditional Order), on the condition that JMP pay a penalty of \$2,500.00 for failing to file its 2019-2020 annual assessment as required by Financial Code section 22107 no later than 14 days after the date of Conditional Order.

JMP is not entitled to reinstatement of its CFL license in that JMP has failed to pay the penalty of \$2,500.00 as required under the Conditional Order.

18 Further, on or about December 16, 2021, and January 11, 2022, JMP notified the 19 Commissioner by email that JMP has decided to cease operations and was "commencing the 20 dissolution of the entity."

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition be denied.
