# **Career Executive Assignment (CEA)**

STATE OF CALIFORNIA | Business, Consumer Services, and Housing Agency

### **CEA Positions:**

Career Executive Assignments (CEAs) are state employees in high-level managerial positions primarily responsible for policy implementation and extensive participation in policy evolvement. These positions have continuous, direct interface with department directors and in their respective departments are considered the Director's top management team.

Consider a rewarding career as a CEA with the DFPI to help us build and promote outstanding leadership and a highly engaged, collaborative workforce.

## Who Should Apply?

CEA positions are open to all applicants who possess the knowledge, abilities, and any other requirements as described in the job posting. Eligibility to take a CEA examination does not require you to be a state employee.

## How to Apply:

Applicants can either mail a completed State Examination/ Employment Application (STD 678) along with a Statement of Qualifications as described in the job posting or submit an application package electronically through your CalCareers Account at <a href="https://www.calcareers.ca.gov">www.calcareers.ca.gov</a> by the final filing date.

# **Hiring Process:**

The State of California's hiring process for CEAs requires the administration of an examination. The CEA job posting includes detailed information such the job description, duties, salary, application instructions, desirable qualifications, examination information, and required application package documents.

The examination process typically consists of an application, resume, and Statement of Qualifications evaluation. The Statement of Qualifications is a narrative discussion of how the applicant's experience, education, training, knowledge, skills, and abilities qualify them for the position.

Once the examination has been administered, the department divides the successful candidates into six ranks based upon their scores. The department can appoint anyone in the top three ranks. Hiring interviews for the position may be conducted with the most qualified candidates.
