3	1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the licensing and regulation of persons and		
4	entities engaged in the business of finance lending or brokering under the California Financing Law		
5	(CFL) (Cal. Fin. Code § 22000 et seq.) ¹		
6	2. Respondent PACIFICCAL DEBT IV, LLC, FKA PCCP CAPITAL XXI, LLC		
7	(Respondent), is a Delaware limited liability company with its principal place of business at 10100		
8	Santa Monica Boulevard, Suite 1000, Los Angeles, California 90067. Respondent is licensed by the		
9	Commissioner under the CFL with the license numbers 60DBO-85446, -85447, and -85448.		
10	II.		
11	Violation and Citation		
12	3. Under Section 22150, the Commissioner may make general rules and regulations and		
13	specific rulings, demands, and findings for the enforcement of, and within the general purposes of,		
14	the CFL.		
15	4. Pursuant to a Commissioner's Order on Electronic Communications, dated Novembe		
16	22, 2013, each CFL licensee must establish an email address for communications from the		
17	Commissioner (Designated Email Address).		
18	5. Under California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 1422.4, which went into		
19	effect on October 1, 2021, all CFL licensees were required to transition to the Nationwide Multistate		
20	Licensing System and Registry (NMLS) by December 31, 2021. On December 16, 2021,		
21	Complainant extended the deadline to transition to NMLS to March 15, 2022. On March 7, 2022,		
22	Complainant again extended the deadline to transition to NMLS to March 31, 2022.		
23	6. Complainant provided notice of this requirement to Respondent – via email to the		
24	Designated Email Address provided by each CFL licensee on July 20, 2021, September 16, 2021,		
25	October 14, 2021, November 8, 2021 and December 16, 2021. Complainant also provided notice via		
26	email to each CFL licensee that had not yet transitioned to NMLS, including Respondent, on March

1 7, 2022, and again via email and mail on March 28, 2022. Complainant provided further notice of 2 this requirement over the telephone - Complainant made at least two calls to the designated 3 telephone number provided by each CFL licensee, including Respondent – between February 1 and 4 March 15, 2022. 5 7. Complainant determined that Respondent was in violation of Regulation 1422.4 and had not transitioned management of its CFL licenses to NMLS as of July 29, 2022. Accordingly, 6 7 Complainant issued a Citation on that date pursuant to Financial Code section 22707.5, subdivision 8 (a). The Citation included an order to correct the violation and an order to pay an administrative fine

in the amount of \$2,500.00 to the Commissioner by September 27, 2022.

8. Complainant served the Citation on Respondent via certified mail on July 29, 2022.

9. To date, Respondent has neither complied with the order to correct the violation by transitioning each of its licenses to NMLS nor paid the administrative fine.

III.

Applicable Law

10. Subsection (a)(1) of Section 22714 provides that the Commissioner shall suspend or revoke any CFL license, upon notice and reasonable opportunity to be heard, if the Commissioner finds that the licensee has failed to comply with any demand, ruling, or requirement of the commissioner made pursuant to and within the authority of this division.

2	WHEREFORE, IT IS PRAYED that	
3	11. Pursuant to subsection (a)(1) of Section 22714, the California Financing Law licenses	
4	of Respondent PACIFICCAL DEBT IV, LLC, FKA PCCP CAPITAL XXI, LLC, be revoked due to	
5	the lengthy duration of the violations identified above and Respondent's failure to comply with the	
6	Citation.
