

THE CALIFORNIA CORPORATIONS COMMISSIONER HEREBY ADOPTS
THE FOLLOWING CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS UNDER THE
FRANCHISE INVESTMENT LAW
AS SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 3, TITLE 10,
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS
EFFECTIVE: SEPTEMBER 4, 2002

1. Repeal Section 310.100.1

~~310.100.1. Out of State Sales.~~

~~There is hereby exempted from the provisions of Section 31110 of the Code as not being comprehended within the purposes of the Franchise Investment Law and the registration of which is not necessary or appropriate in the public interest or for the protection of investors, any offer or sale of a franchise to a resident of a foreign state, territory or country who is neither domiciled in this state to the knowledge of the seller nor actually present in this state, if the franchised business is not to be operated, wholly or partially, in this state, and if the sale of such franchise is not in violation of any law of the foreign state, territory or country concerned or of the United States.~~
